#### **Community Organizer**

Washington Village/Pigtown Neighborhood Planning Council's (WPNPC) Public Safety Team seeks a Community Organizer to play a central role in implementing the organization's social change goals and strategies. Primary among these strategies is developing grassroots leadership and working to address public safety and sanitation issues. This position has an emphasis on issues of concern to low-income, racially diverse residents in the Washington Village/Pigtown community, including economic, racial and environmental justice.

#### **Requirements**

A person applying for this position should demonstrate enthusiasm for building a strong grassroots social justice organization and hold a deep commitment to racial and cultural diversity. S/he must be able to work independently and cooperatively, be self-motivated and self starting, and able to facilitate democratic decision-making. Strong accountability to the organization is required, as is a willingness to work flexible hours with frequent travel. Driver's license required and personal transportation preferred.
